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DESCRIPTION

This two day conference will address both cutting edge and practical issues in surgical pathology, in line with new volumes of the AFIP Fascicles, in 2018 and 2019. Key topics include salivary and sinonasal lesions, contemporary issues in breast needle biopsies, pathology of lung tumors in the modern era, gastrointestinal and liver pathology, and bone and soft tissue pathology with radiologic correlation. The course format will include lecture and case-based sessions with encouraged questions and discussion from attendees.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND

This activity is intended for pathologists, nurses, NPs, PAs and pathology residents.

OBJECTIVES

After attending this activity, the participant will demonstrate the ability to:

- Increase synergy between radiologic and pathologic evaluation of skeletal lesions.
- Define diagnostic criteria and molecular underpinnings of lung adenocarcinoma.
- Recognize and diagnose key gastroesophageal precancerous processes.
