The best connection between Marco Polo Airport and We_Crociferi is water transport. The water bus service is provided by the company Alilaguna www.alilaguna.it

On exiting from the Arrivals hall, look for the covered walkway on the left and follow the walkway for 7 minutes until you reach the dock.
